3/30 CLUB GOLF RULES

Courtesy on the golf course makes the game enjoyable for all. KEEP IN MIND THE FOLLOWING RULES AND PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children and will be notified of any infractions of the rules.

All members and guests must register at the clubhouse before playing. When you bring guests, YOU are responsible that they pay green fees and abide by the rules. Guests are limited to playing the course 3 times per year if they live within 15 miles of the course.

GREEN FEES: "2015" (Subject to change)

Weekdays:Non-member - \$17Guests accompanied by member - \$12Weekends & Holidays:Non-member - \$20Guests accompanied by member - \$14

OUT OF BOUNDS SCORING:

In hitting a ball out of bounds, you lose both stroke and distance.

Example: You hit your tee shot out of bounds--tee up another ball, and you are now hitting your 3rd shot.

Example: You hit your 3rd shot out of bounds, you then hit another ball from the same spot and you are now hitting your 5th shot.

No children under 12 may golf on weekends, holidays or after 3 p.m. unless accompanied by an adult.

Children under 14 shall not operate motorized carts unless accompanied by an adult.

Each golfer must have a bag with at least three clubs in it.

Shirts must be worn at all times on the golf course.

Whenever possible, begin play on the first tee; never cut in front of another group already playing if it will cause them to wait. Do not start on #4 or #7 if someone is approaching #3 or #6 green.

Mens Stag: Wednesday afternoon and evening. Course is closed at noon.

Ladies Day: Tuesday afternoon. Course is closed at 2 p.m.

No youth under 16 shall be on the golf course on Tuesday or Wednesday afternoon unless accompanied by an adult.

No golfer should play until the players in front are out of range. Call "fore" if the ball goes in the direction of other golfers.

Never pull cart across any part of the green or tee.

Players searching for a ball should allow other golfers coming up to pass them. They should signal to the other golfers following them to pass and should not continue their play until those golfers have passed and are out of range.

Avoid low, wet areas. Upon posted notice at the first tee, carts may be prohibited entirely because of course conditions. The groundskeeper will determine if motorized carts are prohibited from the course.

No one shall be on the golf course unless playing golf, with the exception of persons at work.

Practicing golf is restricted to areas so designated. No more than two (2) shag balls are to be played at one time.

It is recommended that golfers do not golf in groups of more than four (4).

The 3/30 Golf Course will be open December 1 through March 31 for MEMBERS ONLY. Closing of the course and the use of carts will be at the discretion of the groundskeeper.

Please remember to replace your divots and repair ball marks on the greens.

All golfing members of the 3/30 Club are required to display an official 3/30 Club golf tag provided upon payment of membership dues.

Be advised that the 3/30 Club does not carry Insurance on the contents of the cart sheds. The 3/30 Club assumes no responsibility of the golf carts, golf clubs, etc which members choose to leave in the cart sheds. By agreeing to rent a cart shed stall, the member is agreeing to assume all risk and waives all claims against the 3/30 club for property theft, damage or other form of loss.
