3/30 CLUB SWIMMING RULES

Successful and safe operation of the 3/30 Club pool is not the sole responsibility of the management or the lifeguards. They only help you make the use of the swimming facilities as safe and pleasurable as you wish. PLEASE READ THESE RULES AND INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN.

Only members and guests with members may use the swimming pool. A fee of \$5.00 per guest must be paid when the guest registers. <u>Non members may use the pool SIX times a year. Unlimited use for non members outside the 15 mile radius</u>. All members are responsible for their guests.

Lifeguards have full authority over swimmers and anyone inside the pool fence. They are empowered to enforce all rules and control all behavior.

Parents have the sole responsibility for minor children. Lifeguards are not babysitters.

There shall be absolutely no swimming unless the pool is guarded. Anyone caught doing this will be barred from the pool for the balance of the year.

Bathers shall not appear in the clubhouse, on the golf course, or at any social function in swimming attire.

No person suffering from any form of communicable disease, however mild, may enter the pool.

No obscene language shall be used in or around the pool area.

No street footwear shall be worn on pool deck area.

No swimming in any clothes except swimming suits.

Showers must be taken before entering the pool.

No calling for help unless needed.

Boisterous conduct such as running, shoving, dunking and splashing is prohibited.

No food, drinks, empty glasses, bottles, cans or sharp objects are allowed in the bathhouse or on the pool deck.

No face masks, flippers or snorkels are to be used in the pool except with permission of the lifeguards. No artificial supports (lifejackets, belts, etc.) on children or adults without permission of the lifeguard on duty. No unauthorized use of pool rescue equipment.

No swimming within three (3) feet either side of the diving board or within seven (7) feet of the end of the diving board, when board is in use.

Only one (1) person on the diving board at a time. Dive only when the area is clear. Never dive off the side of the board. No show-off diving or jumping either from the diving board or from the pool edge.

PLEASE use the restroom facilities, not the swimming pool.

The lifeguard reserves the right to test anyone's ability to swim and inform that person of the area of the pool that he/she may use.

Strict attention shall be paid to the whistle of the lifeguard. It means attention.

Improper conduct or repeated infraction of the rules may be cause for dismissal from the pool temporarily, or for the season, at the discretion of the pool committee and subject to appeal to the 3/30 Board of Directors.

The pool can be rented for private parties. Contact the pool manager for details.

If you have any concerns or suggestions, please take them to the 3/30 Board of Directors.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE CLUBHOUSE IF YOU HAVE A COMPLAINT. CALL THE POOL MANAGER OR A MEMBER OF THE 3/30 BOARD.
